FUNCTIONAL VISION ASSESSMENTS

The first step in building your child's development and learning plan is for a credentialed Teacher of the Visually Impaired (TVI) to work closely with them to determine how your child sees.

The results will form the foundation for next steps in classes and support at CVI or in other settings. We can also help you learn how to best support your child's needs.

The results of the assessment will help you understand how to accommodate your child's visual needs and how to best support their growth, development and learning at home and prepare them for school.

Frequency: Three meetings with CVI

- Interview with parent(s)
- The assessment: working one on one with your child
- Reviewing the report and recommendations for next steps

Fee: \$600

Follow Up Functional Vision Assessment:

CVI offers a follow up functional vision assessment for families who are currently active with the BEGIN program who desire an up-to-date assessment of their child's visual functioning.

As your child grows and develops, their visual functioning may change. This is especially true for children with Cortical Visual Impairment. The Follow Up Assessment is performed at the six month mark of receiving CVI services. CVI's Teacher of the Visually Impaired will evaluate the same skills from the first assessment and create a new report.

Requirement: Must be a current recipient of services at the Center for the Visually Impaired.

Fee: \$300

Once your child’s Functional Vision Assessment is complete, we will meet with you to recommend next steps for your child’s learning and development.

These recommendations often include a series of individual and group classes. We often begin with individual classes and then recommend advancing to group classes as your child develops. The group classes are great opportunities for your baby to develop socially and for you to meet other parents. CVI offers a range of classes (i.e. *Baby and Me* and *Music in Movement*). Class theme changes from season to season.

Individual Class \$75/hour

- Series of Three (3) Individual Classes \$220
- Series of Six (6) Individual Classes \$445

Parent Coaching Session \$75/hour

- Series of Five (5) Sessions \$350

Group Classes \$160/month

Parent Education Classes

- Individual Classes (Four [4] per year) \$30/class
- Series of Four (4) Classes \$115/series

Additional parent education opportunities may be offered during the year with pricing based on the nature and length of the programs

INDIVIDUAL EDUCATION PLAN CONSULTING (IEP)

CVI's credentialed Teachers of the Visually Impaired can review your child's Individual Education Plan and provide counsel about services that might benefit your child in their learning and development.

Review and recommendations regarding current IEP **\$250**

IEP review and participation in IEP meeting with parents and school **\$400**

Parent Coaching for IEP meetings **\$75/hour**



COLLABORATIVE CARE AND PLAN COORDINATION

CVI's teachers are available to meet with other educators or healthcare providers who are supporting your child or your family. These are opportunities to coordinate care and education plans to ensure your child receives the greatest possible benefit from the range of services they are receiving.
